Mr. and Mrs. Rogers Go To Africa



In May, Gerry and I visited Rwanda, Africa, with World Vision. World Vision is a Christian humanitarian organization dedicated to working with children, families, and their communities worldwide to reach their full potential by tackling the causes of poverty and injustice. We are continuing to share some of the experiences we had, people we met and their stories, and how World Vision is helping to improve their lives and many people like them.

In the last newsletter I told you about sweet little Esther, her village and their struggles without clean water. I want to share with you a little more of what Gerry and I experienced in a Rwandan village that World Vision (and people like you and me) have helped by bringing them clean water.

In Rwanda, like many areas, there are many natural springs. The problem is that there is no way for them to get the spring water out to communities and villages without help. World Vision uses pumps and pumping stations to pump the water out of the springs to holding tanks. From the holding tanks, the clean spring water is then pumped up higher to another holding area. It is cleaned and disinfected during this process. From the high holding tanks, World Vision's engineers then use gravity to send it down through pipes to the local villages.





Gerry and I were able to visit a village where World Vision has brought clean water. Wow! What a difference in this village compared to Esther's village!! We were privileged to meet with the elders of the community who shared with us all about how their water system works and how much better things are because of this clean water.

When water runs from the holding tanks down to the village it comes to a central tap where the villagers come to collect their water. They do have to walk a little to get this clean water, but NOT NEARLY as far as they did before to collect DIRTY water! World Vision makes sure that the water is no more than a quarter mile (imagine 2-3 city blocks) from anyone collecting. Each village has a water manager who stays at the water tap to watch the tap and to collect a



nominal fee for the water. The money collected helps to maintain the pumps, tanks, etc, but also gives the people a sense of responsibility and pride of ownership. They are paying for their water and their water system, so they take better care of it and also do not waste this precious water.

And speaking of responsibility, World Vision doesn't just go into these villages and GIVE them clean water. This is not just a hand out. World Vision teaches them how to use the water properly and how to take care of their water system so that they can maintain it all on their own. In other words, World Vision doesn't give them a fish, but teaches them HOW to fish! A hand UP, not OUT! What a concept, right? Before any village receives clean water, World Vision educates them on HOW it all works and then requires them to have 5 key things in place before they can receive clean water.

- 1-Elevated dish area (keeps clean dishes off the ground)
- 2-Well-built latrine (a toilet area)
- 3-Rubbish pit (keeps garbage away from clean area)
- 4-Tippy tap (hand washing station)
- 5-A place to bathe (area designated for showering or bathing)

Along with these 5 must have elements, the villagers are also taught all about hygiene, like washing hands after using the restroom, etc.



Isn't that a much better way to give? Educate and help people in need learn how to sustain themselves instead of just giving a hand out and soon it goes right back to the way it was before? 
